LANDRY GETS KEY ENDORSEMENT AND RATING

In the past month, the Landry for West Texas Campaign has received vital endorsements in the race for State House District 83. The Communications Workers of America (CWA) Local 6203 endorsed Democratic Candidate Drew Landry and just last night Texans for Public Education rated Landry as “friendly” to their cause for public education.

“This is a tremendous honor to have the CWA’s endorsement and the ‘friendly’ rating from Texans for Public Education,” Landry said. “Public education is the backbone to lowering property taxes, a better workforce, and a stronger Texas. It is truly great to be the only candidate in the race for District 83 rated as ‘friendly’ by the group.”
